Who Should Submit

We invite submissions from:

- Academic researchers and scholars
- Defence and security professionals
- Policy analysts and practitioners
- Graduate students (with faculty endorsement)

What to Submit

Submissions may include:

- Original scientific research
- Review papers
- Preliminary communications

Or

- Professional papers (practice-oriented, policy, or applied case studies)

All accepted papers will be published in the Conference Proceedings (ISSN 3044-6104). Professional papers will appear in a separate issue within the same volume.

Topics of Interest

The conference welcomes submissions across key defense and security domains. For more information, please refer to the Call for Papers.

How to Participate

The submission process involves:

- Abstract submission
- Full paper submission (upon acceptance of abstract)

Presentation Requirement

At least one author must present the accepted paper at the conference — in person, online, or via poster (as assigned). Papers not presented will not appear in the published proceedings.
